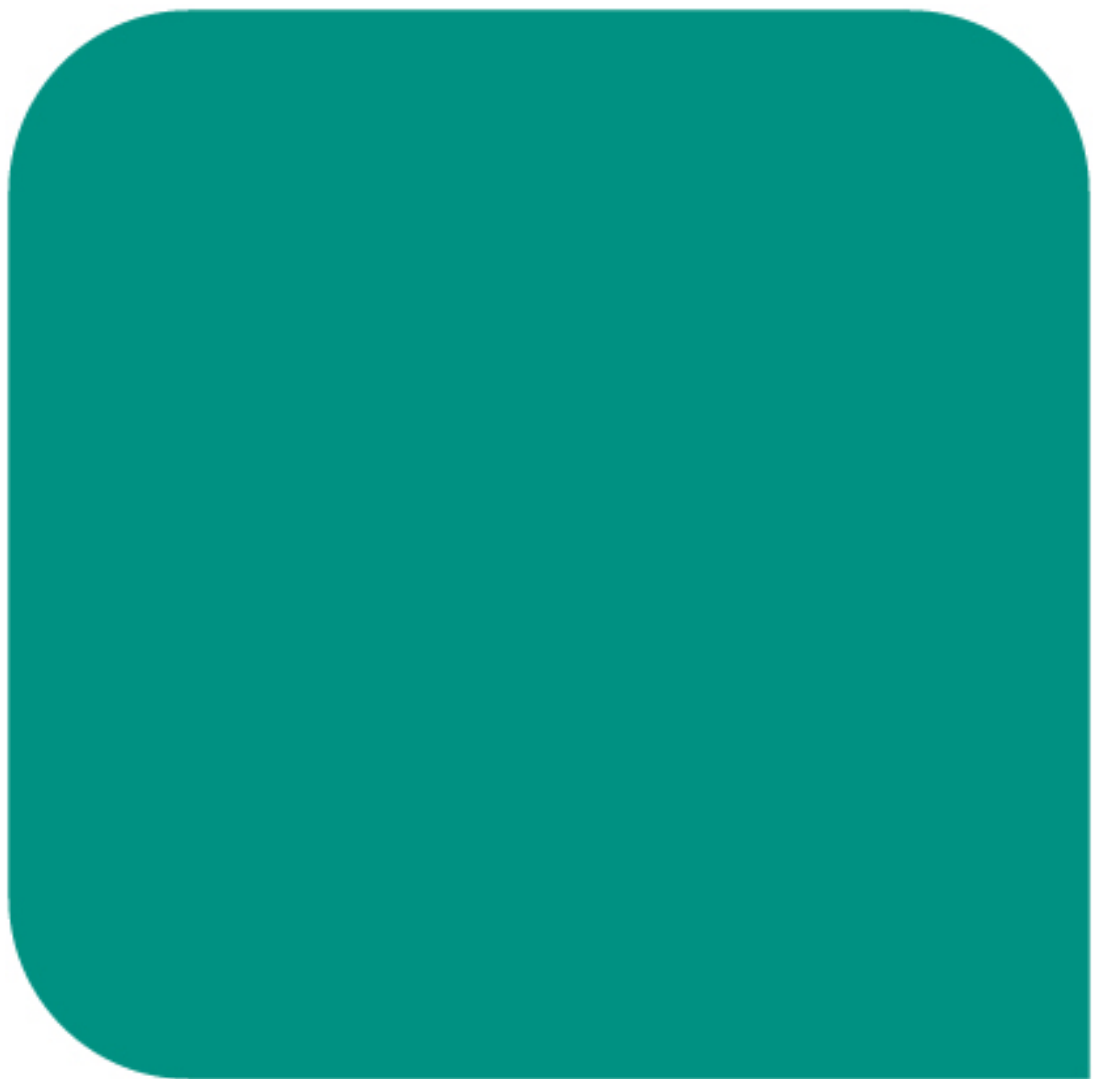




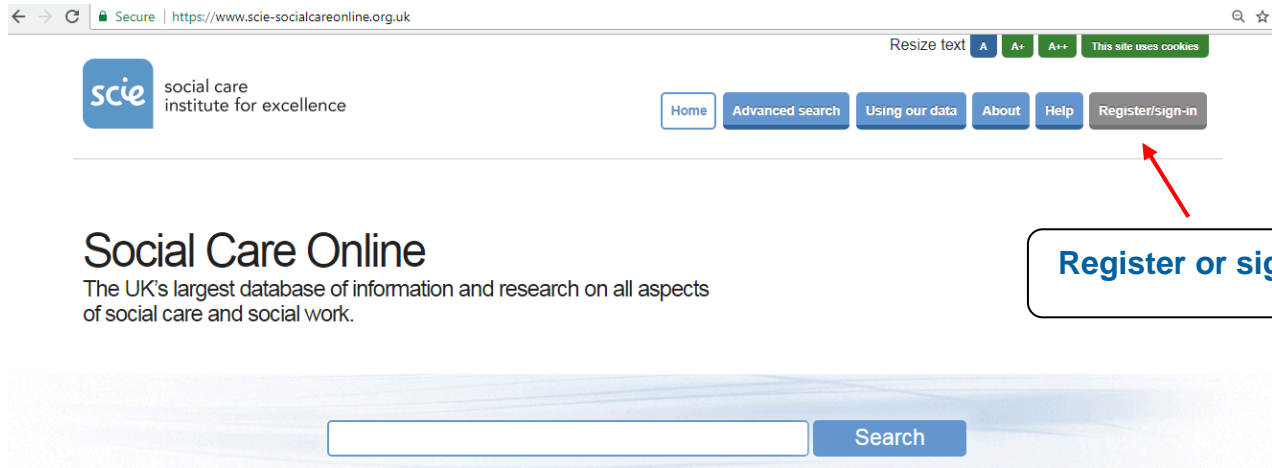

## Standard search guide

- Google-type search for quick searches on single words, multiple words or phrases that appear in Social Care Online records
- Refine or narrow search results using a number of different filters (eg publication date, author, publication date)

The Prime Minister has called for a 'people power revolution', a radical devolution of power to people across large swathes of public services. This report, from a group of civil society leaders, supports that vision of devolving power to people and communities. The aim of the report is to set out key practical steps which are needed to move from rhetoric to reality and to affect a real people power revolution. The first chapter sets out a vision for what a real people power revolution would involve, arguing that it requires the devolution of real power over public services to people. Chapter two identifies five of the most critical building blocks that will need to be in place to underpin a new generation of people-powered services: bottom-up regulation and quality assurance; a revolution in the provision of information, advice and advocacy; a new mutuality to drive up provider and workforce capacity; supporting prevention and the development of social capital; and large-scale social investment. In each case it sets out the principles which should govern the response to the major challenges, and some steps to meet them. Chapter three illustrates what people-powered public services might look like in comparison with the status quo, using a series of fictional case studies.

## Icons

Each record has a symbol to indicate the type of resource it is and if the full resource is freely available or not.

 Free resource	A resource available in full text
 Journal article	Articles from journals (peer-reviewed and non peer reviewed), magazines and newsletters.
 Book	Books and reports available in print or online via the internet. Includes commercially published material, government publications, research reports, pamphlets, and briefing papers.
 Digital media	Multi-media and none print media eg SCIE SCTV films, e-learning material and interactive online resources. CDs and DVDs are also included.
 Journal	Journal records provide a short description of the coverage of a title and provide a link to the home page of the journal, magazine or newsletter when available.

Content types	Circular, consultation document, government publication, inspection report, learning resource, practice example, research, research review, standards, statutory guidance, statistical publication, systematic review
Publication year	Year of publication
Subject terms	Subject terms from the Social Care Online thesaurus
Authors	If there are more than 3 authors, only the first is given and et al is used
Editors	If there are more than 3 editors only the first is given and et al is used
Location	Geography indexing on Social Care Online is applied at country level, e.g United States, Norway  The individual countries of the UK: England, Wales, Northern Ireland and Scotland are also used to index material
